Mayor, Councilmembers Sworn In

Wylie, TX, May 21, 2014 – Wylie Mayor Eric Hogue and Councilmen-elect William Whitney III (Place 5) and David Dahl (Place 6) were sworn in Tuesday, May 20. Whitney replaces Mayor *pro tem* Rick White, and Dahl replaces Councilmember Diane Culver. Hogue was unopposed, and the incumbents did not seek re-election. Judge Terry Douglas administered the oath of office to the mayor, who is beginning his third term, and the two new members of Wylie City Council. Outgoing and incoming members were honored with a reception at Wylie City Hall.
