**City of Wylie Receives Financial Reporting Award for 25<sup>th</sup> Year**  
*City Celebrates Silver Anniversary of Accounting Excellence*

**Wylie, TX, Sept. 3, 2014** – The City of Wylie has been awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada for its Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2012-'13. The award marks a silver anniversary for the city; it's the 25<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that Wylie has been honored with the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting.

“We are proud of our staff’s commitment to transparency and excellence in reporting,” said City Manager Mindy Manson. “It is an honor to receive this award for the 25<sup>th</sup> year in a row.”

Reports submitted to the CAFR program are reviewed by selected members of the GFOA professional staff and the GFOA Special Review Committee . The SRC is comprised of an impartial panel of public-sector financial statement preparers, independent auditors, academia, and other finance professionals. The CAFRs are judged on a set of standards including their ability to demonstrate a constructive “spirit of full disclosure”; effectiveness in communicating the entity’s financial story; and ability to motivate potential users to read the CAFR.

The goal is to encourage and assist governments to go beyond the minimum accepted accounting principles and prepare CAFRs of the highest quality according to a stringent set of guidelines; and to recognize individual governments that succeed in achieving that goal.
