**Wylie Fire Rescue to Deliver Pizzas, Check Smoke Detectors**

*WFR Teams Up with Domino's, NFPA to Promote Fire Safety*

**WHAT:** Wylie residents ordering Domino's pizza at 4 pm on Wednesday, Oct. 8, may be randomly selected and surprised at the door when their pizza arrives aboard a Wylie fire truck. Upon delivery, firemen will check the smoke detectors throughout the home. If all detectors are working — the pizza is free. If the detectors are not working, firefighters will replace the batteries and leave the home with functioning alarms.

“Having working smoke alarms in your home cuts the risk of dying in a fire in half, but it's easy to forget about the batteries,” said Capt. Wesley Gheen with Wylie Fire Rescue. “So make sure your detectors are working, and we may be knocking at your door – with a free pizza!”

The program is part of the National Fire Protection Association's Fire Prevention Week Oct. 5 – 11. This year's theme is “Working Smoke Alarms Save Lives: Test Yours Every Month!”
