Family Bike Parade Celebrates New Hike, Bike Trail

Wylie, TX, July 20, 2015 – The City of Wylie celebrated completion of its new Municipal Complex hike and bike trail with a Family Bike Parade July 16. The trail is 1 mile long and 12 feet wide and loops around the library, recreation center and city hall. The trail goes through meadows and woods, including a 20-foot pedestrian bridge over a creek.

The trail was funded largely through grants from the Collin County Parks and Open Space Program and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, along with the City of Wylie Park Land Acquisition and Improvement fund.
