City Utility Billing to Sell Toll Tags

Wylie, Texas, July 7, 2017 – Wylie Utility Billing has teamed up with the North Texas Tollway Authority to become a regional toll tag partner and will begin selling toll tags and setting up new toll tag accounts July 17.

At the Utility Billing windows, drivers can set up new toll tag accounts and pay to initially load the toll tag. Credit cards are the only acceptable form of payment. Cost to set up the account is \$20, and the cards can be loaded up to \$40.

Once the account is set up, customers will need to contact NTTA to reload the tag, add vehicles, or for any other questions. An NTTA pamphlet will be provided at the time of setup. There is also an app that can be downloaded to reload cards and check balances through NTTA.
