Records Analyst to Assume City Secretary Role

Wylie, Texas, Jan. 25, 2018 – Stephanie Storm, records analyst in the Wylie City Secretary’s office, will take over as Wylie’s new City Secretary when Carole Ehrlich retires at the end of January.

Storm has worked for the City of Wylie for 11 years. She began as part-time administrative assistant to records management and assumed the position full time in 2007. After mastering and expanding the duties of this role, the job title was changed to records analyst in 2011.

Storm is a Texas Registered Municipal Clerk and a member of the Association of Records Managers and Administrators. She has been asked to speak several times at the Laserfiche National Conference. Storm was named the City of Wylie Employee of the Year in 2015.

“Stephanie has worked hard to obtain the knowledge and experience needed to take over this complicated role, and she also has the service-minded leadership skills that we look for in our organization,” said City Manager Mindy Manson. “We are excited to have the opportunity to promote from within and know that she will do an outstanding job.”

“I am honored that Stephanie will be the new City of Wylie City Secretary,” said Ehrlich. “She will keep the department moving forward to serve the citizens of Wylie with transparency and great customer service. I could not imagine a more qualified person.”

Storm’s husband Brandon is a driver/engineer with Wylie Fire Rescue, and they live in Wylie with their sons Liam, Cooper and Asher.
