### Jazz Performances

- ◆ **Tatiana LadyMay Mayfield**, a premier scat jazz vocalist, whose fans describe her sound and persona as refreshing and beautiful. She was a hit in London and was chosen as one of only 12 semi-finalists to perform at the Smithsonian Museum of the Native American in Washington, D.C.
- ◆ **Quamon Fowler**, Texas-born tenor saxophonist and premier recording artist who performs straight ahead and contemporary jazz.
- ◆ **Sky Window**, a progressive electronic jazz fusion collective featuring alumni of the University of North Texas' Jazz Studies program. This group's sounds keep listeners engaged throughout their musical journey.

- ◆ **Landon Torbett**, a top area artist committed to re-establishing smooth jazz in the North Texas Region.
- ◆ Other performers include **Ray Baker Project**, **Crosswinds Jazz Band** and jazz ensembles from area high schools and junior high schools.
