Rules and Guidelines

Terms and Definitions

The following terms are defined as relates to Wylie Recreation Facility Rules and Guidelines, including the Facility and all Areas within the Facility. Terms and definitions include the plural form of the word(s).

Annual Recreation Pass	ID card purchased from the City of Wylie Recreation division and assigned to an individual Guest, valid at Wylie Recreation Center for three hundred and sixty five (365) days from issue.
Annual Childcare Waiver	Liability waiver that holds the City of Wylie harmless, valid for the current calendar year for participation in the Childcare Area.
Authorized Drop Off/Pick Up	Person the City of Wylie may receive/release a Childcare Area participant from/to per written request by the Parent or Legal Guardian.
City	City of Wylie
Dependent	A person, youth through elder, under the care of a Parent or Legal Guardian.
Employee	Person employed by the City of Wylie Recreation division.
Facility / Recreation Facility	Any City of Wylie Recreation designated grounds, parking lots and buildings. May be on-site or off-site.
Family Restroom	Toileting facilities designated for unisex use.
Guest	Person inside a City of Wylie Recreation Facility.
Guest Services Desk	Control desk area at a Facility where Guests may check out equipment, register for activities, receive information about programs and activities, request Rental information and make payment for recreation services.
Instructor	Person coordinating City of Wylie Recreation sanctioned Registered Activities under valid Instructor Agreement with the City, and not an Employee.
Instructor Agreement	Agreement and terms between a private party and the City of Wylie to provide instructional services.
Open Climb	Designated hours the Climbing Wall Areas are available to Recreation Pass Holders for self-guided climbing.
Open Fitness	Designated hours the Fitness Areas are available to Recreation Pass Holders for self-guided use of equipment and space.
Open Gym	Designated hours the Gym Areas are available to Recreation Pass Holders for self-guided basketball or volleyball play.

Open Play	Program, activity or area access that is included with a valid Recreation Pass. A collective of Open Climb, Open Fitness and Open Gym.
Parent and Legal Guardian	One or both parents or adult(s) age eighteen (18) or older who have legal custody and authority of their child(ren). Proof of legal guardianship is required.
Recreation Pass	ID card purchased from City of Wylie Recreation division and assigned to an individual Guest. Pass grants access to Open Play.
Recreation Pass Holder	Guest of a Recreation Facility that has a current and valid Recreation Pass.
Registered Activity	City of Wylie Recreation classes, programs and activities requiring preregistration of participant.
Rental	Permitted private use of space by a Guest for a designated timeframe, via established reservation requirements, agreements and payments.
Rental Agreement	Included in Rental Permit. Agreement between the City and Guest for use of a Facility.
Rental Permit	Document provided by City of Wylie Recreation division to a Guest containing the Rental Agreement, dates, times, balance and guidelines for an approved Facility reservation.
Senior	Guests age fifty-five (55) years and older.
