Demo/ Backfilling a Pool

Demo/Backfilling a Pool:

Our inspectors will inspect the electrical and plumbing to make sure they are capped off properly.

Pool bottom will need to be broken up or have holes placed in the bottom for drainage.

General Contractors or homeowners are allowed to pull this permit if they are doing the work.

Required inspections:

Pre Pool Demo – The Inspector will check to see if the plumbing and electrical are capped off properly. Pool bottom to be broken up and/or have holes placed in the bottom for drainage.

Final Pool Demo – to make sure the pool has been backfilled.

The applicant must completely fill out a Residential Building Permit and a fee of \$50.00 is due at the time of application. The permit will be issued over the counter.
