Focus on Roads

To keep up with our growing city of close to 50,000 residents (230% increase in population since 2000), maintain a high quality of life, provide better access to schools and to promote economic development, Wylie has invested and plans to continue to invest in new and reconstructed roadways throughout the city.

Projects and time lines are constantly reviewed and updated to make sure the current and future transportation needs of the city are met within budget.

- 1. Highway 78** (Spring Creek Parkway to SH 205)
Six lane divided; Completion Fall 2017; TxDOT Project
- 2. Parker Road** (Old Parker Road to FM 1378)
Four lane divided; Completion Summer 2017; TxDOT Project

Future Projects:

- 3. McMillen Road** (McCreary Road to FM 1378)
Four lane divided; Stage: Design 95% Complete; Underfunded
- 4. Parker Road** (FM 1378 to Brown Street)
Four lane divided; Bid Letting June 2021
- 5. E. FM 544** (Collins Boulevard to Vinson Road)
Four lane divided; Design to begin Summer 2018
