

PEEPS® on Parade Art Contest Rules

How to Participate

Deliver your entry form and artwork inspired by PEEPS® to Smith Library:

Friday, May 19, between 10 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or
Saturday, May 20, 2017, between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.

Art is on display to the public and for judging from 2 to 4 p.m. on Saturday, May 20. Your family-friendly entry will be judged on creativity and the best use of PEEPS®.

All entries should represent a literary work, be it the original book, short story, poem, or play, or adaptations of the work. Works for which the original is a TV series or film do not meet the criteria. If you're unsure, contact the Help Desk at 972-516-6250, option 3.

Grades K- 4

Grades 5-8

Grades 9-12

Adults 18 up

Family/Mixed-Age

Participant Entry Requirements

- Entry is FREE, and open to all individuals, families, and groups.
- One entry per person or group. You may enter only once as an individual and once as part of a group. Your name may be on only two entries.

Requirements for Entries

- Use any variety of PEEPS® or create your own representation of PEEPS® out of other materials (paint, cardboard, foam, etc.).
- No food materials other than PEEPS® will be accepted.
- All works must fit dimensions listed below:
 - Two-dimensional works must be no larger than 16 in. long x 16 in. wide.
 - Three-dimensional works must be no larger than 30 in. high x 16 in. long x 16 in. deep.
- All works must be well constructed and ready for display. Two-dimensional art must be able to stand on an easel.
- Unfinished cardboard or newspaper must not be visible on the piece.
- Three-dimensional pieces must be finished on all visible sides.
- Smith Library is not responsible for artworks damaged while on display.
- Smith Library reserves the right to edit or refuse any works deemed inappropriate for display.
- Smith Library reserves the right to take photos of art work for use in print and social media.

Judging

The viewing public will judge their favorites among the categories. The two entries with the most votes in each category will be awarded gift cards from Painting with a Twist or for classes at the Wylie Art Gallery. Participants need not be present to win.

Pick Up

Entries not taken after the contest can be picked up
Monday, May 22, before 7:30 p.m. or Tuesday, May 23, before 3:30 p.m.

Entries not picked up by May 23 at 3:30 p.m. will be discarded.
