Wylie, Texas, April 25, 2017 – Wylie Police Department is inviting citizens interested in learning more about law enforcement to apply for the Citizens Police Academy, beginning Aug. 24, 2017, and meeting every Thursday evening from 7 to 10 pm through Nov. 2. Participants must live or work in Wylie and be age 21 or older.
