Wylie Wild Bunch Educating Students on Fire Safety

WHAT: Wylie firefighters known as the Wylie Wild Bunch return to Wylie ISD elementary schools, private schools and day cares with a new 30-minute, live fire prevention program. This year's show, which will be set in a fire station kitchen, will teach such behaviors as turning pot handles in, never placing items on a stove, the importance of smoke detectors, calling 911, EDITH (exit drill in the home), closing the door behind you, and stop, drop and roll.

Capt. Ray Jackson heads up the program; appearing in the performances will be Firefighters Richard Hollien, Jeff Pynes, Michael Towne, Andrew Johnson, Brandon Storm, Brian Moriarty, Cale Wardlaw, Zac Hawkes, Fire Investigator Joe Wetzel and Captain Andrew Johnson.

As in years before, there will be interactive elements to the performance. A set, designed and built by firefighters, serves as the backdrop for this year's show. As always, the Wylie Wild Bunch will bring smiles to kids' faces as they combine lessons and laughter.
