



Wylie Named Ninth Safest City in Texas

Wylie, Texas, June 12, 2017 – Wylie has been named the ninth safest city in Texas among cities with a population of 10,000 or more. The 2017 list was compiled by SafeWise, a security organization, utilizing FBI crime data from 2015. Wylie’s previous rank was 19.

SafeWise noted that the raw data used to calculate each city’s safety score is comprised of information on violent crimes and property crimes.
