Wylie Municipal Court to Hold Warrant Resolution Day

Wylie, Texas, Feb. 6, 2019 – Wylie Municipal Court will hold a Warrant Resolution Day March 8, 2019, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Wylie City Hall, 300 Country Club Rd., Bldg. 100. On this open docket day, citizens with Wylie Class C warrants may come to court without being detained or arrested.

Upon arrival, citizens should check in at the clerk's window on the first floor of City Hall for an opportunity to go before the judge, who will be available to accept pleas, review financial situations, and discuss issues regarding current situations or any changes in citations and/or citation agreements. Citizens may be approved for a second-chance opportunity to dispose of fines and fees.

Citizens are encouraged to resolve outstanding warrants before the statewide Great Texas Warrant Roundup 2019 beginning soon.
