



Stay Home ... Stay Safe ... Save Lives

The Wylie City Council urges residents to stay home to stop the spread of coronavirus. Please follow these guidelines based on the Governor's March 31 Executive Order and the City Council's April 2 Disaster Ordinance that runs through April 30.

Maintain CDC social distancing guidelines of 6 ft. from others

No public or private recreational gatherings or community gatherings

No gatherings in groups of more than 10 people

What is Closed?

- Playgrounds, restrooms, pavilions, water fountains, courts, Rec Center, Senior Rec Center, Smith Library
- Elective medical, surgical, and dental procedures are prohibited
- Dine-in/patio food and drink service
- No visitors to nursing homes, retirement, or care facilities
- Private clubs
- Theaters
- Gyms/Fitness centers/Gymnastics
- Martial arts studios
- Nail salons/Spas
- Hair & beauty salons/Barber shops
- Hair-removal services
- Tattoo/Piercing studios
- Massage (non-medical)
- Other non-medical, personal care services that cannot be provided while maintaining appropriate social distance

- Religious and worship services should be conducted by video/teleconference when possible (Attorney General Guidance)

What is Open?

Trails & Open Space

- Social distance; only play with people from own household. No recreational gatherings or groups of 10 or more (playgrounds/other facilities closed)

Food

- Restaurants, bars, wineries and microbreweries may only provide takeout, delivery, or drive-up service
- Grocery stores
- Farmers markets

Child Care

- For essential employees only; social distancing and 10 or less recommended

Automobile

- Gas stations
- Automobile parts
- Automobile repair shops

Retail

- Big-box stores
- Convenience stores
- Laundromats/Dry cleaners
- Hardware stores
- Pet supply stores
- Office supply

Health Care

- Emergency Rooms
- Dentists (emergency only)
- Pharmacies
- Doctors' offices/Clinics
- Mental health providers

- Laboratory services

- Home health care
- Veterinary care
- Physical therapists
- Chiropractors (medical necessity)

Social Services

- Nonprofits providing food, shelter, and social services

Government

- All services provided to ensure continuing operation of government agencies to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the public

Infrastructure

- Water, sewer, gas, electric utilities
- CWD trash collection
- Residential/Commercial const.
- Telecommunications and Internet
- Computer consulting

Other

- Mail and shipping
- Golf courses
- Cleaning, landscaping and home maintenance, and security services
- Storage
- Funeral homes
- Plumbers/Electricians/Exterminators
- Legal services
- Real estate/Property management
- Bank and financial services
- Safety and security-related services
